Dear Parents and Carers,

You have enrolled your child to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation this year. May the Holy Spirit be with you and your family and bring you much joy as you prepare to celebrate with your child. As you know, the process has changed in the Archdiocese of Brisbane recently. So this year we are only preparing the children for Confirmation. The completion of the journey for **Year 4** will follow this timeline:

Year 4 Confirmation 25 th August 3.00pm	Year 5 Second Rite of Reconciliation & First Eucharist During Easter Season	Year 6 First Rite of Reconciliation During Lent

The dates for preparation for **Confirmation** this year are:

1. Parent Information Evening:
Thursday 19 July 2018 at 7pm.
2. Enrolment Liturgy at all Masses on the
Weekend of 21/22 July.
3. In the weeks following there will be **four** sessions in which parents and children along with a leader will explore the Sacrament of Confirmation.
These four sessions will take place during the weeks beginning:
22 July until 12 August. Times and days will be decided by each group.
4. Penitential Liturgy:
Wednesday 15 August at 7pm.
5. Rehearsal for Confirmation and Parent Session:
Sunday 19 August, At 10:30am.
6. Children's Confirmation at St Joseph's will then be held on
Saturday 25 August 2018 at 3pm. One of the Bishops will be the celebrant.

Parents are asked to bring children to the Community Centre by 2.30pm on Saturday the 25 August. They will be under the supervision of teachers and team leaders. Sashes will be fitted. After the Confirmation, families and friends are invited to share supper in the Gathering Area. Photos will be taken of the Confirmation cake which will be cut and distributed.
