Dear Parents and Carers,

You have indicated that you wish to enrol your child to prepare for the Sacrament of Eucharist in 2018. May the Holy Spirit be with you and your family and bring you much joy as you prepare to celebrate with your child. During this preparation children will make their First Reconciliation according to the First Rite (Communal celebration with Individual Confession). Then in the following year, 2019, they will be invited to make a Reconciliation during Lent according to the First Rite (Individual Confession and Absolution).

The dates for preparation for **First Eucharist** in 2018 are:

1. Parent Information Evening: **Thursday 26th April at 7pm.**
2. **Enrolments close on Friday, 27th April at 2.00pm.**
3. Enrolment Liturgy at all Masses on the **Weekend of 28th/29th April.**
4. In the weeks following there will be **four sessions** in which parents and children along with a leader will explore the Sacrament of Eucharist. These will take place during the weeks beginning: 29th April, 6th May, 13th May, 20th May.
5. **Family Day:** On Sunday 27th May we are having a family day during which the children will celebrate First Reconciliation according to a simple Second Rite. There will also be a tour of the Church and an opportunity for parents to give some feedback on the process.
6. The children will receive their **First Eucharist** at any of the Masses on the weekend of 2nd and 3rd June, the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ.
7. You may make an offering of \$30 per child for the preparation.

They will be under the supervision of teachers and team leaders. Sashes will be fitted.

After the Masses on First Communion day, families and friends are invited to share the community for refreshments the Gathering Area.

We pray that preparing your child to receive these Sacraments will be a rewarding experience for you and your child.
