### **Call for Youth Group Ministry**

The aim of this parish based youth gathering is to offer men and women within our parish, school and local communities an opportunity to encounter Christ through sharing Prayer, Fellowship, Formation, and Good Works; and to empower them to live as disciples of Jesus Christ in our world today. We call on parents to please encourage their children to attend our first meeting scheduled for 4pm on Friday 30th April 2021.
