Remembering St. Joseph!

On Friday, March 19th, few of our parishioners gathered to celebrate our Parish Feast Day, honouring St. Joseph. This year's feast of St. Joseph takes on a very special meaning as Pope Francis has instituted this year as the year of St. Joseph from Dec. 8, 2020, to Dec. 8, 2021. This is to mark the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of St. Joseph as patron of the Universal Church, declared by Pope Pius 9th in 1870.

If you haven't read it already, I highly recommend that you read Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter about St. Joseph, **Patris Corde**, which means **"With a Father's Heart."** The insights he provides about Joseph are profound.

When we think of Joseph, it is his faith, courage and, actually, his silence that we recall. We don't hear or read his words, but we observe many of his actions, all of which are rooted in faith. Faith in God, faith in God's promises, faith in his role as Jesus' father, faith in his wife, faith in his son. We have no record of God communicating with Joseph other than through dreams, so when things became difficult for Joseph and the dreams seemed faded and far away, he undoubtedly had to dig deeper and rely on his faith, and let that faith feed his courage.

In his apostolic letter, Pope Francis gives us insight into this man who played an important role in salvation history. He writes, *"Joseph was the man chosen by God to guide the beginnings of the history of redemption. He was the true 'miracle' by which God saves the child and his mother. God acted by trusting in Joseph's creative courage."*

In Matthew's Gospel, we hear the everyday words describing Joseph as Mary's husband and she as his wife. How simple and normal those words are, describing a relationship we are so familiar with. Yet an angel had appeared to Joseph in a dream, calming his fears and his plans to divorce Mary, and he woke with new determination and most likely peace. And history would never be the same.

There's no doubt whatsoever that Joseph was a righteous person and a great man of faith. I am not proud to say that we have too often overlooked Joseph, or only thought about him at Christmas and on March 19. We are all inspired to follow Pope Francis' lead and immerse ourselves this year in learning much more about this special man and to reflect on the meaning, example and courage his faith and fatherhood offers us all. Happy feast of St Joseph to you all!
