EASTER SUNDAY of the RESURRECTION of the LORD Year B - 4th April, 2021

"Building a community of Jesus' disciples." We welcome you - We are one family

*This weeks Readings:
Acts 10:34, 37-43; 1 Cor 5:6-8; Jn 20:1-9*

***'Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive?
He is not here, he is risen!' Lk. 24:6.***

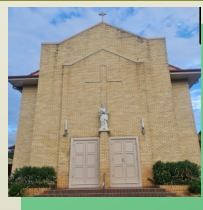
This marvellous message from St. Luke was announced to the women who went to visit Jesus' tomb on the early Easter morning. Jesus was not dead; he was alive! But we have that inclination to still look for him who is alive among the dead. It is not enough to study the story of Jesus like the life of any other great historical figure. We begin that way, but we must end by 'encountering' him. To the early Christians Jesus was not some vague figure from the past. They believed that he was alive and present to them after his death, although in a radically different way. And that is the way believers regard Jesus to this day.

As Christians, we don't just believe that Jesus rose from the dead, we believe that he is alive. He is not a heroic figure of the past, but a living person. He is not a memory, but a presence. The Easter proclamation is not 'Christ *rose* from the dead.' It is 'Christ is *risen*.' In other words, we speak of Christ not in the past tense but in the present tense. Our Resurrection faith asserts not only that Jesus rose from the dead but also that, through the power of the Holy Spirit, he has actively remained present in the world, and in particular, in the lives of every Christian. We can find powerful signs of his presence in examples of holy living, and in all sorts of good works on behalf of the poor, the needy and the marginalised. Good works carried out in the name and through the power of the crucified and risen Jesus, such works suggests his living presence.

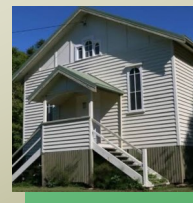
The Christian is not someone who knows about Jesus, but someone who knows Jesus. The greatest scholar in the world who knows everything about Jesus is less than the humblest Christian who knows Jesus through faith. The Easter narrative transcends knowing about Jesus. It is a story about knowing Jesus personally, experiencing his presence through faith, and bearing witness to his presence.

Christian worship, above all in the Sunday assembly, was and remains the primary 'place' where people can experience the risen Christ. Through worship we come to know Christ as a marvellous and living friend, who bears the mark of our sorrow and pain, takes joy in our happiness, will share our last hour, and receive us into his kingdom in death. Christ's presence enables us to face all the evil and hatred we hear about daily, and still have hope. May his victory enable us to live our lives under the brightness of immortality.

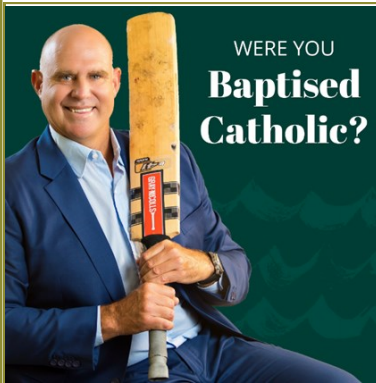
