On Sunday morning, the **22nd of August**, there is a mini retreat that brings the preparation to an end and the Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated. ## CHRISTIAN MEDITATION

The World Community for Christian Meditation (WCCM) is a global spiritual community united in the practice of meditation in the Christian tradition. It shares the fruits of this practice widely and inclusively, serving the unity of all and building understanding between faiths and cultures. The roots of WCCM lie in the desert tradition of early Christianity in the 4<sup>th</sup> century. Fr John Main (1926 -1982), a Benedictine monk, recognized that the way of 'pure prayer' or 'prayer of the heart' could restore this lost dimension of prayer to the life of the churches.

As a result of John Main's insight the WCCM was formed in 1981. There are now thousands of weekly meditation groups around the world.
