'GIFT' SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM ENROLMENT

Adult converts to the Catholic faith usually do! They progress through a journey known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), which is the Catholic Church's official process for the reception of unbaptised adults into the Church through the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. It also provides a process for baptised adults from other Christian traditions to enter the Church through Confirmation and Eucharist, including opportunity for the sacrament of Penance.

Following similar process with the RCIA program is our GIFT (Growing in Faith Together) program, which not only offers unbaptised young adults (our High School Students) the opportunity to be initiated into the Catholic Church through the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, but also helps them to grow their faith.

Whether you are just discovering your faith for the first time or wanting to hit 'refresh' on something you've known all your life, Growing in Faith Together - GIFT is perfect for you. Easy to follow and with engaging content, you can walk through the 7 WEEKS supported by staff and students from St John's College, Good Sam College Bli Bli and St Joseph's Catholic Parish. Every week we have a different topic to discuss and we have great people who can answer your questions. Below is the GIFT sessions Timeline for 2021:

- ◆ **30th July – 10th Sept: 3.30pm - 4.30pm** - Seven weeks preparation: Ryan Room, St Joseph's Community Centre (Preferred day is Friday)
- ◆ **August 21st 3-5pm** - Twilight/Reconciliation: Mass: 6pm St Joseph's Catholic Church, and Community Centre Nambour (supper included)
- ◆ **11th Sept 3pm** - Baptism: St Joseph's Catholic Church, Nambour
- ◆ **11th Sept 4-5pm** - Twilight Reflection: St Joseph's Community Centre, Nambour
- ◆ **11th Sept First - 6pm** - Mass – Holy Eucharist/Confirmation - St Joseph's Catholic Church, Nambour
