Our Church receives much criticism, both fair and unfair - from the wider community and from within the Church community itself. Some of this criticism is justified of course, such as the past handling of sexual abuse issues. We cannot, and must not shy away from these issues. Other criticisms are not always justified. But the Catholic Church as an organisation will always be a target, for a range of reasons.

However, it is far more productive to focus on what our Church is doing in terms of its mission – to bring Jesus Christ to the world. I never forget that our Church is *universal* - much, much bigger than a parish in which we live – important though that parish and its family are. And a lot of the work carried out throughout the world by the Church is unheralded. And when I say "Church" I mean *people* – all of us in all of our ministries.

Here are some examples of our Church at work: *Catholic Mission* is the official mission aid agency of the Catholic Church. Catholic Mission operates in over 50 countries to support initiatives in 1100 dioceses, including remote Australia; and the agency provides essential funding for the Church's projects in Africa, Asia, the Pacific and parts of South America.

*Caritas Australia* is the Catholic Agency for International Aid and Development in Australia. The organisation is part of Caritas Internationalis, an international confederation of 165 Catholic relief, development and social service organisations, working to build a better world for the poorest of the poor in over 200 countries and territories.

The *St Vincent de Paul Society*, a lay Catholic organisation, operates internationally in 149 countries and has over 950,000 members and volunteers worldwide. The members and volunteers reach out to the most vulnerable in our community. In Australia, more than 2 million people are assisted each year.

For more than 50 years *Centacare* Brisbane has been the social services arm of the Catholic Church in the Archdiocese of Brisbane, working in partnership with various levels of government and the community. In our archdiocese alone, a Centacare workforce of more than 3000, including volunteers, responds to local needs from over 200 small service sites throughout southeast Queensland touching the lives of more than 150,000 people each year.

For over 90 years, the Catholic Church throughout the world has been providing pastoral care to the people of the sea via '*Apostleship of the Sea – Stella Maris*'. Every year thousands of seafarers are welcomed in ports at the Stella Maris Centres – places where seafarers are warmly received, can relax away from the ship and make contact with family members using different means of communication made available to them.

The root of the word "mission" means "being sent". Mission is why Jesus has called the Church into being. Whilst we are experiencing a difficult time in our Church, it is important that we don't lose sight of who and what we are called to be, as participants in bringing Jesus Christ to the world. *Have a wonderful week!* *Deacon Tim*

## ARCHBISHOP MARK HAS A MESSAGE FOR YOU

This week is NAIDOC Week - and you're probably wondering what NAIDOC stands for. Well, it stands for National Aborigines and Islanders Day Observance Committee. And it's a day to celebrate all that our First Nations peoples bring to us and to remember how much has to be done in the name of reconciliation. We were due to have a special NAIDOC Mass in the cathedral last Sunday, but COVID-19 put paid to that. The Mass may have been cancelled but not the need to celebrate and remember. In the Archdiocese we have recently adopted a very good [Reconciliation Action Plan](#). It commits us to action to heal the deep wound that stops Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians walking the road together. Not even COVID-19 can stop that.
