"The Lord is my Shephard..."

After the "The Lord's Prayer," today's responsorial Psalm is perhaps the most famous piece of Scripture in the world. It presents us with the vitally important image of the shepherd, the true shepherd, in trying to understand God and our relationship with him.

The imagery of sheep and shepherds might seem ancient to today's modern and sophisticated society, but the quest for true leadership is always vital and lasting. The ancient Israelites hailed the LORD as their leader, yet eventually they craved to have a king like all the other surrounding nations. As the Scripture teaches us, the role of kingship in the historical account of the Israelites is both glorious and apprehensive. After the noble achievement of David and Solomon, it became a divisive and corrupting influence on the people of God, as human selfishness and stupidity led to political and moral collapse.

However, out of the mess of history and human failure, God promised through his prophet to send a true leader who would love and guide his people in the future – the Shepherd-King. **"I will raise up shepherds to look after my flock and pasture them" (Jer. 23:4).** This shepherd image is then expanded and merged into one of the true kingship: **"See the days are coming when I will raise a virtuous branch for David, who will reign as true king and be wise" (Jer. 23:5).** Then, the image of the Messiah is given its definitive poetic expression for all time in the message of the Psalm with all its promises of peace and safety: **"he guides me along the right path; he is true to his name" (Ps. 23:3-4).**

He cares for each one of us with a tender love, as we know Jesus does from the Gospel. St. Mark tells us "As he stepped ashore, he saw a large crowd; and he took pity on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd" (Mk. 6:34). Jesus comes as the embodiment of the true shepherd of the sheep. The true leader is known for his wise decision and sure guidance, and St. Paul writing to the Ephesians shows us how in Jesus we will have true peace. He breaks down barriers of pride and prejudice; he brings true reconciliation, and shows us the inner meaning of God's plan.

We follow the Law as a sign of our love for him, not in order to establish our own righteousness. With his kind of leadership we can follow with confidence, and help fight the vain stupidity of the human condition through the peace he creates between us. Following Christ bestows on us the greatest of Messianic promises: **"Surely goodness and kindness shall follow me all the days of my life" (Ps. 23:6).** Let us pray today for the grace to always dwell in God's house forever.

NEW LAWS TARGETING SEXUAL OFFENCES AGAINST CHILDREN

target behaviour which ignores or hides child sexual abuse. The new laws mean that all adults in Queensland now have a legal duty to:

- * report sexual offending against children by other adults to the police; **and**
- * protect children from the risk of sexual abuse by other adults in an institution (e.g. a school, church or sporting club).

The laws commenced on 5 July 2021 and carry up to 5 years imprisonment.

The Archdiocese has zero tolerance for all forms of abuse. Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.

A reminder the Government has introduced new laws that

- ◆ Wearing of Masks remains mandatory for indoor spaces.
