Call for Nomination to the Parish Pastoral Council for 2022

The Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) is an assembly of people in the local faith community - priests and laypersons; dedicated to provide consultation, advice, or decision-making help on overall life and ministry of a particular faith community. The pastoral council aims at helping the people of God "to collaborate energetically in every apostolic and missionary undertaking sponsored" by the parish.

Parish council members – whether elected or appointed – have a specific share in the people of God's pastoral mission to evangelise the world. Parish councils' reflections on vital grassroots faith concerns, the decisions they render in collaboration with pastors, and the Christian witness they give to entire communities make the great effort to form and maintain them worthwhile.

As a passionate and purposeful team that will support this Parish's future direction, the primary role of the PPCT will be to advocate this Parish's mission to live and communicate the love and values of Christ throughout our community, to help unify our local faith community, share in responsibility for decision on parish pastoral matters, set mission statements, goals, objectives, and assist in other pastoral-planning elements in our local faith communities.

Parishioners are invited to nominate a fellow parishioner or even yourself for consideration to the PPCT. Forms to facilitate this are available in the church and on the back of the newsletter. You can also contact the parish office by phone of email to submit your nomination. The PPCT must be a diverse team representing many different activities in the parish. Please give prayerful consideration as you reflect on this important duty, and if possible, speak to the person before nominating him or her. Please return the form to the parish office no later than 21st November 2021.

November, the Month of the Holy Souls – In the month of November we focus our prayerful intentions upon our deceased loved ones, family, friends, past parishioners and all who have died especially those who have no one to remember them. You will notice, during Mass, envelopes on the altar of the church. These are the envelopes on which are written the names of your loved ones for whom you have asked Masses to be offered. November Mass envelopes are available at the entrance of the church. Let us continue to keep our deceased loved ones in our prayers.

The Good News



Archbishop Mark has a message for you

We once thought of some countries as "mission" countries and others countries,

like Australia, as "non-mission" countries. But now every country is "mission" territory as we move through this change of era when the Church has to be rebuilt in new ways. Still, there are some parts of the world where the Good News of Jesus has not been heard at all or heard only as the faintest whisper. That's why we celebrate each year we celebrate October as World Mission month. This focuses us on the need to pass on to others the Good News we have received from Jesus – to all people, wherever they are, but especially to those who are most needy. So many live in a world where there seems to be only bad news. This is not what God wants, and that's why we can't just shrug our shoulders and look the other way. Catholic Mission focuses on specific projects, like the home for vulnerable mothers and babies in Bangkok run by the Good Shepherd Sisters. Here we see that spreading the Good News of Jesus isn't just a matter of words. It has to become action; and our financial support makes that action possible. That's why each October we have the Mission Sunday collection. It's a call to understand more deeply that our Baptism makes us all missionaries in one way or another. So I commend this year's collection to your generosity and the work of Catholic Mission to your prayer.

PARISH COVID-19 UPDATE & EVENTBRITE BOOKING SYSTEM

The following restrictions are in place here at St. Joseph's Parish during this time:

A. Government Regulation:

All parishioners must sign in through the QLD Check-in App

- B. Archdiocesan policy—Ticketed seating all parishioners must receive a seat number from the marshals. 100% capacity for ticketed when allocating seating when permitted. Ticketed seating means a person is given a ticket with their seat number on it and will remain (as much as possible) in their allocated seat while at the place of worship. This also means we need your name and contact details for Parish records, to record the number of your seat
 - C. PLEASE continue to use the Eventbrite Mass booking system:

- D. **Masks** must be worn in indoor or outdoor spaces if you are closer than 1 person per 2 square metres.
- E. Clergy and readers who are socially distanced from others may remove their mask while speaking and then put the mask back on.
- F. **Parishioners** may remove their masks momentarily for reception of Holy Communion.
 - G. The choir and cantors are required to wear a mask at all times.
