- ♦ Currently we are sitting at a surplus for the year of \$24k but in saying that we have a \$221k loan that was on interest only during Covid. We have just started repaying that at \$1500.00 month + interest. If we take this into consideration for next year we would be paying \$18k in loan reimbursements and our surplus would drop to \$6k. As you can appreciate this does not put us in a good situation if we were to have anything happen or if any major repairs or maintenance is required.
- ♦ Thanks to those parishioners who have accepted to be nominated as members of the Parish Pastoral Council Team for 2022. Names of the new PPC members will be made available to parishioners in due time.



A. Government Regulation:
