- ◆ Currently we are sitting at a surplus for the year of \$24k but in saying that we have a \$221k loan that was on interest only during Covid. We have just started repaying that at \$1500.00 month + interest. If we take this into consideration for next year we would be paying \$18k in loan reimbursements and our surplus would drop to \$6k. As you can appreciate this does not put us in a good situation if we were to have anything happen or if any major repairs or maintenance is required.

## Archbishop Mark has a message for you

Through these Advent days we focus on waiting, especially waiting for the God who comes. We have to learn, again and again, the art of patience. For some of us this is a challenge temperamentally; but for all of us it's a challenge culturally. Ours is an impatient culture that doesn't want to wait. We want everything instantly. This was true even before mobile phones became an obsession. But now with phone in hand we have instant access to an infinite amount of information and diversion. In such a culture we may need a dose of digital fasting to help us learn the art of patience. Because the most important things in life just can't be forced. They have a time and rhythm of their own. The coming of God into human history or into my life has a time and rhythm of its own. God doesn't work according to our sense of time; God isn't like a mobile phone that does what we tell it when we tell it. Sometimes we think that because God doesn't work according to our sense of time, God isn't working at all. But in fact the divine sense of timing, however different from ours, is perfect. That's why we need to learn patience, be prepared to wait and tune into the timing of God.

## PARISH COVID-19 UPDATE & EVENTBRITE BOOKING SYSTEM

The following restrictions are in place here at St. Joseph's Parish during this time:

### A. Government Regulation:

All parishioners must sign in through the QLD Check-in App

B. **Archdiocesan policy—Ticketed seating** - all parishioners must receive a seat number from the marshals. 100% capacity for ticketed when allocating seating when permitted. Ticketed seating means a person is given a ticket with their seat number on it and will remain (as much as possible) in their allocated seat while at the place of worship. This also means we need your name and contact details for Parish records, to record the number of your seat —

You no longer need to wear a mask except in the following limited circumstances:

- ◆ If you have been in an impacted or locked down area in the last 14 days, you must continue to wear a mask until 14 days have passed (nb: there are currently no impacted areas in Queensland).

- ◆ It is still advisable to carry a mask with you in case you aren't able to maintain physical distancing and when you are on public transport.
