Luke 4:1 - 13: Jesus Tempted in the Desert

The temptation of Jesus reflects the temptation that of all humanity experiences. Humanity was first tempted in the garden of Eden when Satan tempted Eve. Israel was tempted in the desert during the Exodus. We are still tempted today; as disciples of Jesus our lives reflect that of our Lord, including temptations. Eve was tempted to take food in the form of a forbidden fruit. Israel was tempted to hunger after the food they had enjoyed in Egypt. Jesus was tempted to turn stones into bread. We are tempted with food, alcohol, TV, the internet; in fact, anything that gives us gratification.

Eve found the fruit a "delight to the eyes" (Gen 3:6), she desires something other than God. Israel "forgot the God who saved them" (Ps 106:21), they worshiped a golden calf. Jesus is tempted to desire power from ruling secular kingdoms, at the cost of rejecting God. We too can be tempted with power through money, position, reputation, or anything that will allow us to control other people. Power can come at the cost of neglecting God, or even denying God or part of His teaching.

Eve is asked by Satan, "Did God say, 'You shall not eat of any tree of the garden?'" She is tempted to doubt God, putting God to the test. Israel tested God in the desert when they asked whether God could really provide food for all the people in the desert. Jesus is tempted to put God to the test by throwing himself off of the temple parapet. We can be tempted to rely too heavily on ourselves or on secular powers. It is as if we forget God loves us as our true Father and that we can rely on Him.

To counter these temptations, the Church provides us with three penitential disciplines; fasting to help us grow in self-control. Giving alms to help us to develop detachment from possessions and power. Prayer helps us to remember how good God is; we learn to be less reliant on ourselves and to trust God more. Disciples of Jesus take on the "discipline" of Jesus. Let us all take on these disciplines and encourage each other to persevere in them with the help of Jesus.
