**RCIA Update**

Our parish community has been journeying with Ivor Johansson this year through the RCIA program. On Sunday ... Ivor celebrated **his Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens** here in our parish, where he properly marked the beginning of his catechumenate journey. In this first liturgical rite, he publicly expressed, and the Church represented by the whole gathered assembly accepted, his intention and desire to respond to God's call to follow Christ's way.

The second step of the RCIA journey is the **rite of Election or Enrolment of names**, usually celebrated on the first Sunday of Lent, by the Archbishop at the Cathedral in Brisbane. In this liturgical rite, the Church officially ratifies the catechumen's readiness for the sacraments of initiation and the catechumen, now the elect, express the will to receive these sacraments. Unfortunately, due to the recent flooding and its damaging effects, Ivor could only celebrate this important second step of his RCIA journey here at the parish on Friday 11 March, instead of at the Cathedral.

From next weekend, the Third Sunday of Lent, Ivor will move to the third step of his sacramental journey – **the period of Purification and Enlightenment**. This is a time immediately preceding the elects' initiation. It is a time of deep reflection, intensely centred on conversion and marked by the celebration of the First, Second, and Third scrutinies, and presentations and of the preparation rites on Holy Saturday. The scrutinies will be celebrated each week during the 8am Mass, from the Third – Fifth Sundays of Lent.

Also, following the instructions from the liturgical rubrics, since the YEAR A gospel readings for the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent are of major importance in regard to Christian initiation, we'll be using the YEAR A readings for the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent instead of YEAR C readings. Please let's continue to keep Ivor in our prayers.

### Archbishop Mark has a message for you

First COVID, then [the floods](#). Just when you thought it couldn't get worse there was the [horrific invasion of Ukraine](#), which may seem far way away but is really at our doorstep, because the struggle in Ukraine has global implications. It's a struggle between two very different ways of organising human society – let's call them democracy and autocracy. Since the break-up of the Soviet Union, Ukraine has sought to govern itself as a democracy where the people rule, and in recent times Russia has become increasingly an autocracy where one man rules, brutally. Ukraine dreams of independence and freedom, Russia dreams of regaining a lost empire. Sadly Russia even claims religious sanction for its genocidal attacks on Ukraine, with the head of the Russian Church promoting the war. This is the kind of thing that not only divides Christians but gives Christianity a bad name. It shows what happens when the Church is tied absolutely to nationalism. The Church has long struggled to maintain its freedom from the state, and for good reason. Christianity is tied to no nation, to no nationalist cause or ideology. That's why the separation of Church and state has been one of the West's greatest achievements. So say a prayer for Ukraine and for the peace of the world – that truth and not lies will prevail, that peace and not violence will have the victory.
