**Holy Eucharist Enrolment**

On Sunday morning, the **12th of June**, there is a mini retreat that brings the preparation to an end and the Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated.

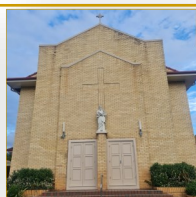
