Luke 10:1 – 12, 17 – 20: The Kingdom is at Hand

During Israel's Exodus from Egypt, Moses appointed seventy elders to assist him in settling disputes between the people. The elders were to act as judges and as a type of council. By the time of Jesus, the ruling council of leading Jews, known as the Sanhedrin, comprised seventy or so council members who were all highly influential.

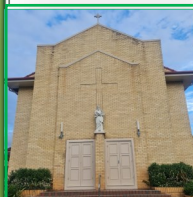
By sending out seventy-two people (some manuscripts state seventy), Jesus is announcing He is the new Moses. He is forming a new Israel. This action would have been highly provocative to the existing Sanhedrin. In the first century of Roman-occupied Israel, people were expecting their long-awaited Messiah. Anyone who could stand up and declare that they were the Messiah would gather a following. False messiahs had arisen before Jesus's ministry and after His earthly ministry as well. Here was Jesus working miracles, healing the sick and raising the dead; He might *really* get a following. To top it all, here is Jesus declaring, “the Kingdom of God is at hand” and He is empowering His followers to do likewise. No wonder the Sanhedrin felt so threatened.

To declare that the Kingdom of God is at hand is to proclaim God’s judgement on the people. The people will either receive or reject those announcing the Good News. There will be those who receive healing, teaching, and freedom from demonic oppression and those who prefer to keep the status quo.

The alternative kingdom that Jesus is instituting is not one of military or political power. It is a kingdom founded on peace. “Shalom” in Hebrew refers to peace in all spheres of life. It has the context of harmony, wholeness, completeness, and moral value. Shalom is connected to the idea of perfection and ultimately is a divine attribute.

We can live this peace. The first place that peace must take root is in our hearts; This may entail letting go of all that robs us of peace: power, prestige, distractions and even our worries. It will entail embracing the simple joy of being loved by God, trusting God, and opening our hearts to love others.

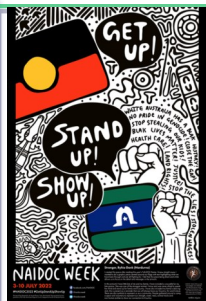

Inner Peace in Divine Love, Nambour QLD - Jesuit and Ignition Spirituality Australia A Four Week Retreat in Daily Life

This First Spiritual Exercises retreat runs over four weeks in daily life. It guides you in prayer and reflection for 30mins each day. The retreat is for anyone who desires to grow in their relationship with God.

The retreat was composed by Michael Hansen SJ and is based on the Spiritual Exercises by St Ignatius of Loyola. This retreat is a way of encountering the Creator as Love in your everyday life through a program of personal prayer and attending a weekly gathering of guided spiritual conversation – online or in person.

What's involved—no fees

- ◆ Participants pray at home for 30mins each day, and meet together with retreat guides within a group once a week for 90mins, for listening, prayer and spiritual conversation.
- ◆ There are five 90min group meetings.
- ◆ These sessions guided by trained givers of the First Spiritual Exercises.
- ◆ It is suggested that you purchase "The First Spiritual Exercises: Four Guided Retreats" book by Michael Hansen SJ ahead of the retreat. Although hard copy resources are supplied freely on a weekly basis.
