REFLECTION: *Set no obstacle in seeking to heal your brother's wound*

When you are offended, are you willing to put aside your own grievance and injury in order to help your brother's wound? The Lord Jesus wants to set us free from resentment, ill-will, and an unwillingness to forgive. The love of Christ both purifies and sets us free to do good to all - even those who cause us grief.

With God's help we must seek to make every effort to win them with the grace and power of God's healing love and wisdom. Let's pray for the grace to tolerate broken relationships and to seek to repair them as God gives us the opportunity to mend and restore what is broken!

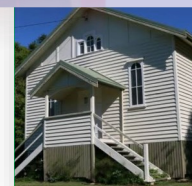

MESSAGE FOR YOU**

The Good News
from the Archdiocese of Brisbane



Finally we know the date for the Referendum vote. As with political elections, I wish in some ways the vote was tomorrow. Not that this is like voting in a political election. The Referendum process has been badly politicised, with politicians and activists on both sides trying to smash the opposition rather than unite the nation. But the choice on 14 October is moral and ethical rather than political. Some say that a Voice to parliament and executive will divide the nation, but we are already divided. The question is how Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australia can be brought together at a time when the gap isn't closing but growing wider. For Christians, the issues focused by the Referendum need to be viewed through the lens of the Gospel and ultimately with the eye of Jesus who isn't above or apart from the process. In preparing to vote for the good not of some but of the whole nation we need to listen carefully to the Uluru Statement but also and more especially to the voice of Jesus.
