Reflection - the Solemnity of Ascension

We can sometimes fail to see the importance of Christ's Ascension into heaven; Christ has completed his mission on earth, he has paid the price for our sins, and risen from the dead – time to go home to the Father! We may even think of Jesus waiting in heaven with nothing in particular to do until the consummation of the earth. Scripture tells us otherwise.

Paul reminds us that Jesus is seated at God's right hand (Eph 1:20, Col 3:1, Heb. 1:3, 1:13, 8:1, 10:12, 12:2), a position of eminent importance. The Letter to the Roman's tells us that Jesus now intercedes for us (Rom 8:34) and the Letter to the Hebrews goes further, Jesus has entered the heavenly sanctuary with his own blood (Heb 9:12). The work of redemption and sanctification continues in each person's life, and Jesus plays an active role in it.

The Temple in Jerusalem was modelled on the heavenly Temple. On the feast of Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, the High Priest would enter the Holy of Holies and pour out blood in atonement for the people's sins. Atonement is one of the few English words used in Bible translation that conveys accurately the meaning of the original Hebrew. The ritual made the people At-one with God (At-one-ment/Atonement). The High Priest poured out the blood of a bull in the holiest part of the Temple; the only day of the year he was allowed to enter the inner sanctuary.

Jesus is our High Priest. He has entered the inner sanctuary of the heavenly Temple. He has poured out His blood so that we may be at-one with God. He makes atonement for our sins. He sits at the right hand of God interceding for us. He asks that our sins may be forgiven, and He asks the heavenly father to send the Holy Spirit to all of his disciples.

Jesus has empowered His disciples to preach the Good News to all creation, to baptise all nations, and to heal the sick. Jesus remains active on our behalf in heaven and is active in His Body, the Church, here on earth. Let us ponder with fresh eyes Christ's redeeming act.
